ABSTRACTS OF THE ARTICLES

The abstracts should be submitted in electronic format (Word text), written in Romanian and English, Word, on A4 paper (2.000 characters), specifying the presentation mode (oral or poster). The authors should specify the section where they will proceed. In order to be included into the symposium programme, we kindly ask you to send us the registration form together with the abstracts by post or e-mail until 31st August 2011.

The text will be edited as follows:

- Title of the paper should be centered, uppercase, bold (font Times New Roman, font size 10);
- The name of the author(s) should be centered, lowercase, bold (font Times New Roman, font size 10);
- Affiliation the full addresses of the authors / of the institutions - should be clearly mentioned (name, street, location, telephone/fax, e-mail), font Times New Roman, font size 10;
- The abstract text should be written with font Times New Roman, font size 10;
- The address for correspondence should be specified.

RECOMMANDATION FOR THE POSTERS

Dimensions of the poster: 90 cm x 150 cm. The content of the poster:

- title, author(s) name, institution will appear in the upper part;
- objectives;
- results (figures and tables with legend);
- discussions;
- conclusions;
- references;
- iconography (photos, flyers, leaflets etc.)

All mentioned aspects should be suggestively presented, clearly and succinct described.

The posters should be mounted by authors on panes.
